Wittenberg University Invests in TimelyCare to Support Students 24/7

Challenge

Before partnering with TimelyCare, Wittenberg University offered on-campus health services. However, with out-of-state students and others with limited financial and healthcare resources, the school needed to find ways to fill gaps in care.

“We had several interests in pursuing virtual care to supplement our counseling center,” said Matthew West, M.S., LPCC-S, director of student counseling. “One of which was that we needed quicker and easier access to psychiatry services.”

Wittenberg University needed to:

- Provide on-demand support for students, particularly during evening and weekend hours and on school breaks
- Increase access to psychiatry services
- Support out-of-state students
- Help students overcome barriers to care, such as cost, insurance, and transportation

50% of users said they would have done nothing if TimelyCare was not available to them

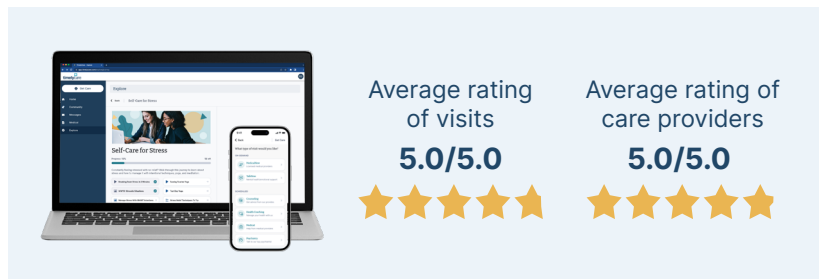

Solution

Wittenberg University partnered with TimelyCare to provide a comprehensive care solution that ensured students had easy access to care. "TimelyCare increased options for students outside of face-to-face counseling," said West. "It has given students options for reaching out for support after hours and during time away from campus when the counseling center is unavailable." The school expanded students' access to care with:

- On-demand emotional support
- Scheduled counseling
- Advanced psychiatric care
- On-demand urgent medical care
- Scheduled medical support
- Health coaching
- On-demand self-care tools and resources
- An online community of peers



Results

When students need after-hours appointments, in-the-moment care, or support over breaks, TimelyCare helps fill gaps in care. West said the increased access to psychiatric care has made a significant positive impact on out-of-state students, many of whom did not have insurance or financial resources to seek care otherwise. Students were able to get immediate psychiatric care, medication, and follow-up visits, giving them the freedom to concentrate on their academic responsibilities and increase independence on campus.
